- lead 3nd/5th in suit contracts, from 6c we lead 3rd (if we supported partner: small shows a TopH, in switch: attitude
- lead attitude and TOP in NT contracts (but 3rd/5th in Partners suit, when switching: attitude, small = interest)
- 1st discard: in suit: attitude (low positiv), further discards inverted count, in NT: lavinthal, then inverted count
- when following trump we show our distribution: low-high = even # of suits with even cards (eg 4432) and vice versa
- against slams: on Ace-lead 1st pos/neg, 2nd count.
- K from AK in suit contract shows either AK sec or a Single in a side suit, or wishes att. Signal. Acelead=count signaling
- If after Ace-lead both sides know (definitely) there must be a switch then partner signals lavinthal.

2/1 Game-Forcing Principles

- Unless we agree on suit early heavy games before slams philosophy, 3NT is nonserious Slam try
- Whenever we have the choice between 2NT or 3NT, 2NT shows 17-19 and 3NT shows 14-16 HCP bal.
- After a 2/1 response, simple jumps in a new suit are SPL bids in support of partner's suit
- 1♥ 2♣/♦ 2♠ shows extra values (forcing to game opposite a non-GF 2/1 response
- 1♥ 2♦ 3♣ shows 5 + 4 with extra, or 5 + 5 with or without extra
- Opener's immediate rebid of his M is of wide-ranging scope that does not suggest extra length or strength (5c possible)
- Opener's jump to game in his major suggests a light high-card opening with a long strong suit, e.g.
 - ▲AKxxxxxx ♥Kx ♦xx ♣x or ▲AQJ10xxx ♥Kxx ♦xx ♣x
- Opener's rebid of 2M followed by a jump to 4M, shows a better hand than a direct jump to game and a good suit
- Opener's rebid of 2, 3, and then 4 of his major, suggests a bad hand and a mediocre 7⁺ suit.
- Opener's raise of the 2/1 minor suit shows some extra values or some shortness.
- 4th in 2/1 game-forcing sequences is a waiting bid with no better descriptive bid available
- In the absence of a fit being found, a new suit rebid by responder is natural but may be a NT probe.

Whenever 2-way checkback (XYZ) is ON, 2NT is TRF & (showing the desire to play 3...). In all XYZ auctions, rebids by responder of his own suit at the 2 level show 6cds and 8-10 HCP, while jump rebids at the 3 level show a really good trump, set suit and are slam interested. With weaker 6cds suits go thru 24 invit relay or thru 24 GF-Relay.

In non XYZ auctions, responder rebid of his own suit on 2 level shows 6cds 8-10. Jump rebids at 3 level show 6cds GF. Bidding 3/4th suit forcing first and then followed by rebid of the first suit at 3 level set trump suit and show slam interest.

c) In competition

1) Whenever opponents only double we play system (XYZ) on.

2) Further XYZ is on after: 1 - (1 + x) - x/1X - (P/x/xx) - 1Y - (P/x)and 1 - (1 + x) - x - (P/xx) - 1 - (P/x)

XYZ is also on after a 1 overcall, negative double and 1NT rebid which shows a bal. hand (but does not show a stopper):

d) Continuation after the bidding 2♣ - 2♦ / 2♦:

The unbid major suit length is shown up the line. If opener can be balanced or unbalanced after accepting a transfer, the bids 2*, 2* or 2NT show balanced hands. Unbalanced hands are bid on 3 level (and imply therefore 3 cards in the transfer suit). Example:

Leads and Signals

Opening Leads

We lead attitude against NT and 3rd/5th against suit contracts – also in partners suit. From 6⁺c suits, we lead 3rd. When in partners suit the amount of cards is know, a small lead promises a top Honor, where as high card denies. Subsequent leads are 3rd/5th (always current length) or attitude (low=pos) if you judge that this info is more important. Highest from sequences and inner sequences.

From AK in suit contracts we lead the ace when we want partner to give attitude and King when we want count. Alternatively: If we lead the K from AK it can mean that we want to ruff (either AK sec or a single in another suit) In Notrump contracts the lead of the ace requires count and the lead of the King wants partner to throw an honor. Every small card is count.

Signals

We play up side down count and attitude (UDCA) throughout.

On Ace/King: Primary signal when we lead to a trick is attitude/count. In NT : Lead of K wants Partner to unblock, a small card shows inverted count.

Whenever declarer leads to the trick, the primary signal is count. We try to give count whenever necessary.

On the opening lead of the As with the queen in dummy, we always signal count.

With a single in dummy or when known in declarers hand, the primary signal is suit preference (Lavinthal) in suit contract and small=positive in NT-contracts. Bbut in certain situations, we may judge that count is more important. Against slams, we only give inverted count. In no trumps we plays smith echo.

When by the bidding the number of cards in declarers hand is known (e.g after 1NT-2D-2H-3NT) or if it is obvious that count can only help declarer but is not important to partner we both fake the count, i.e we do not give UCDA-count but normal count.
